- The **Parish Precept** for the year from April 2012 to March 2013 has now been forwarded to St Edmundsbury Borough Council. As mentioned last month, we are planning a small increase so that we can support community activities that are under pressure because of a reduction in grants from elsewhere. One of these is the Christmas lights and tree. It was wonderful to see the centre of Clare looking so festive over the Christmas and New Year period the lights are something we can all share and they bring joy to everyone who sees them. We are determined that the lights will feature again next year and so have increased the amount allocated to ensure that this happens.

- CHOC: The Combined Halls of Clare continues to improve the facilities in the Old School Community Centre and the Town Hall. A grant from St Edmunsbury has been used to purchase a fixed projector with sound for Hall 2 in the Old School, with the Parish Council and CHOC meeting the remainder of the cost. This will enable local groups to run powerpoint presentations or to show films. We anticipate that the system will be installed soon. A sound system has been purchased for the Town Hall which features a hearing loop and wireless microphones. In addition the Town Hall foyer has been decorated and new lights are due to be installed in parts of the Old School. More improvements are planned for the future and we hope that 2012 will see an even greater use of the halls.
