As part of the Heritage Lottery Funded Managing a Masterpiece project, this May Access Cambridge Archaeology (ACA) will be giving members of the public the chance to take part in excavations on Clare Castle in Clare Country Park. People of all ages, with or without experience are encouraged to take part!

Until Monday 4<sup>th</sup> March, priority will be given to residents of the parish of Clare, members of Clare Historical Society and students registered at Stour Valley Community School. After 4<sup>th</sup> March, applications are welcomed from all Stour Valley residents



We especially welcome anyone who would like to dig, or host, a 1m<sup>2</sup> test pit in their garden if they live close to the castle.

The project will be run by Dr Carenza Lewis, well-known from Channel 4's *Time Team* and BBC's *Story of England* and *The Great British Story*.
