Magna Carta in Clare Festival – Children’s Procession on Saturday 13 June 2015

As part of the Magna Carta in Clare Festival it is proposed to organise a costumed procession of approx. 100-150 school children from local Primary Schools. We would like to notify all residents and businesses in Clare who may be affected as a temporary road closure will be required to ensure the safety of all those taking part. We do not anticipate any need for parking restrictions on Market Hill or other streets along the route.

The approximate timings for the procession are detailed below:

10:00	Restricted access to Malting Lane as school children will be arriving to gather in Clare Castle Country Park car park.
11:00	Procession leaves from the Country Park car park and proceeds up Malting Lane, crosses Well Lane into High Street.
11:10	Malting Lane and Well Lane re-open to traffic. Procession continues up High Street.
11:20	Procession turns right into Church Street and proceeds towards Market Hill.
11:30	At Bell Corner the procession crosses into Market Hill.
11:40	The procession turns left into Station Road and returns to the Country Park

It should only be necessary to stop the traffic for short periods of time and we will have marshalls at all key intersections. 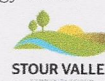
